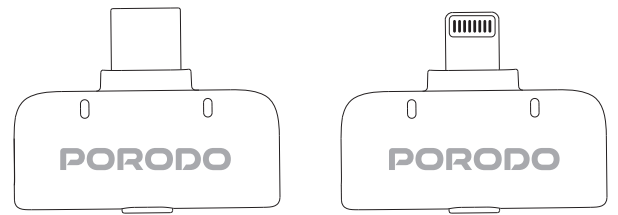

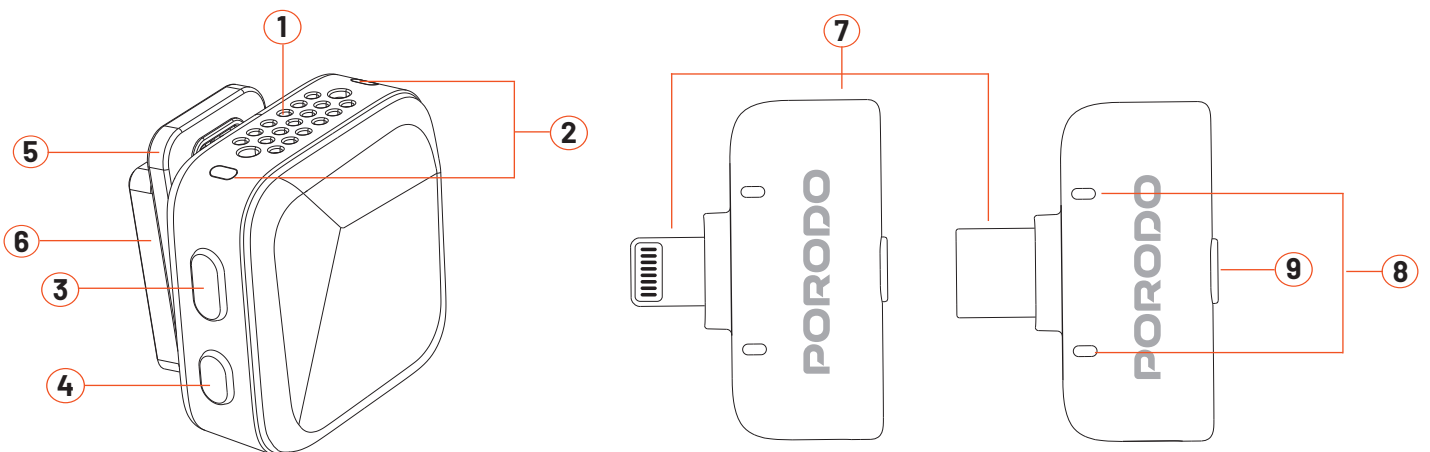

Schematic View

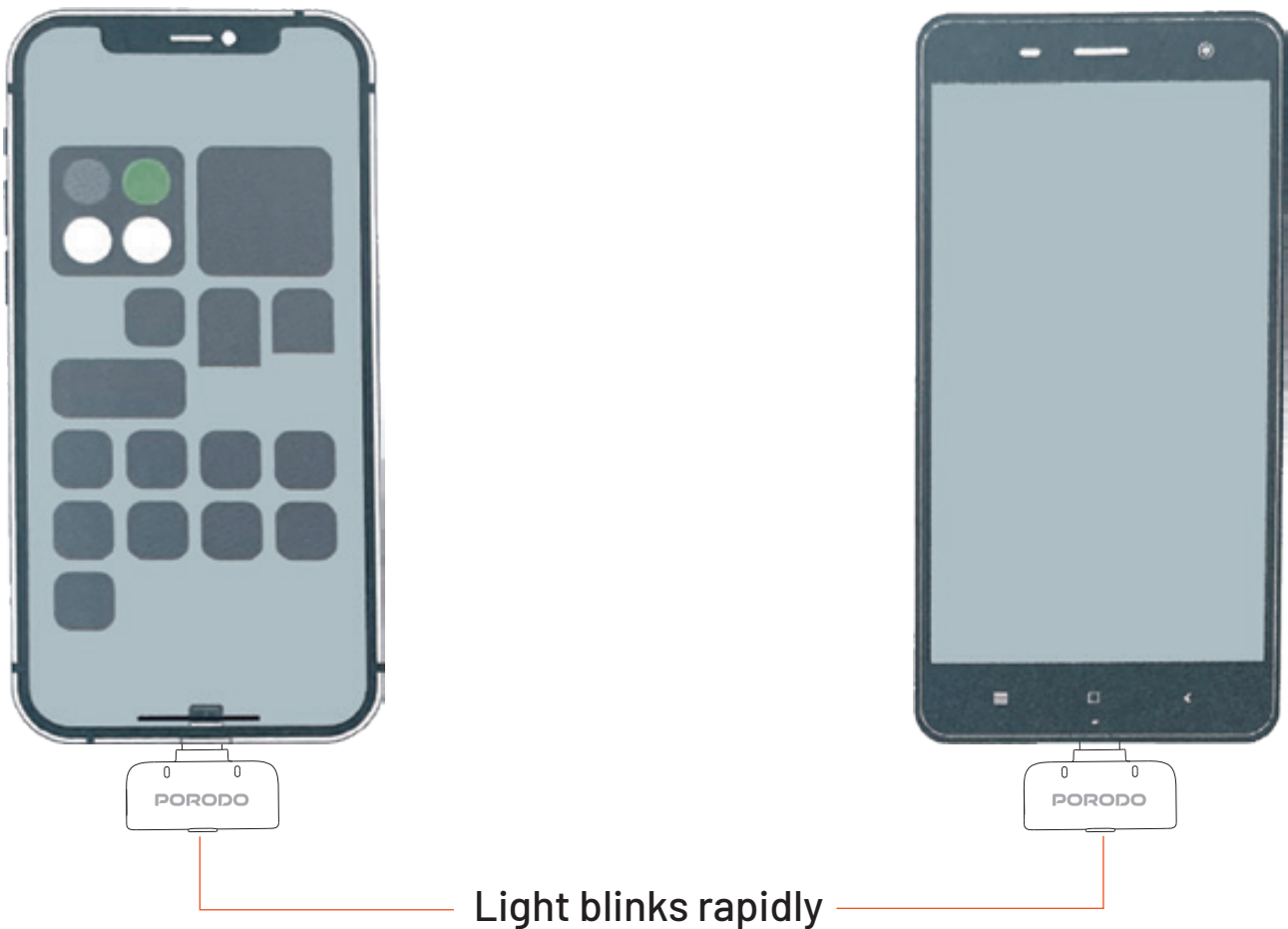


1. Microphone Audio Port

9. Receiver Control Buttons

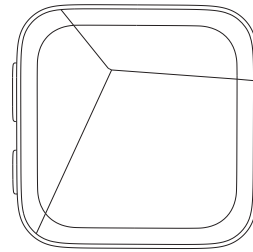
Receiver Usage Instructions

1. Insert the receiver into the mobile phone's port. Once connected, the receiver's light will blink rapidly to indicate that it is properly inserted and ready for use.

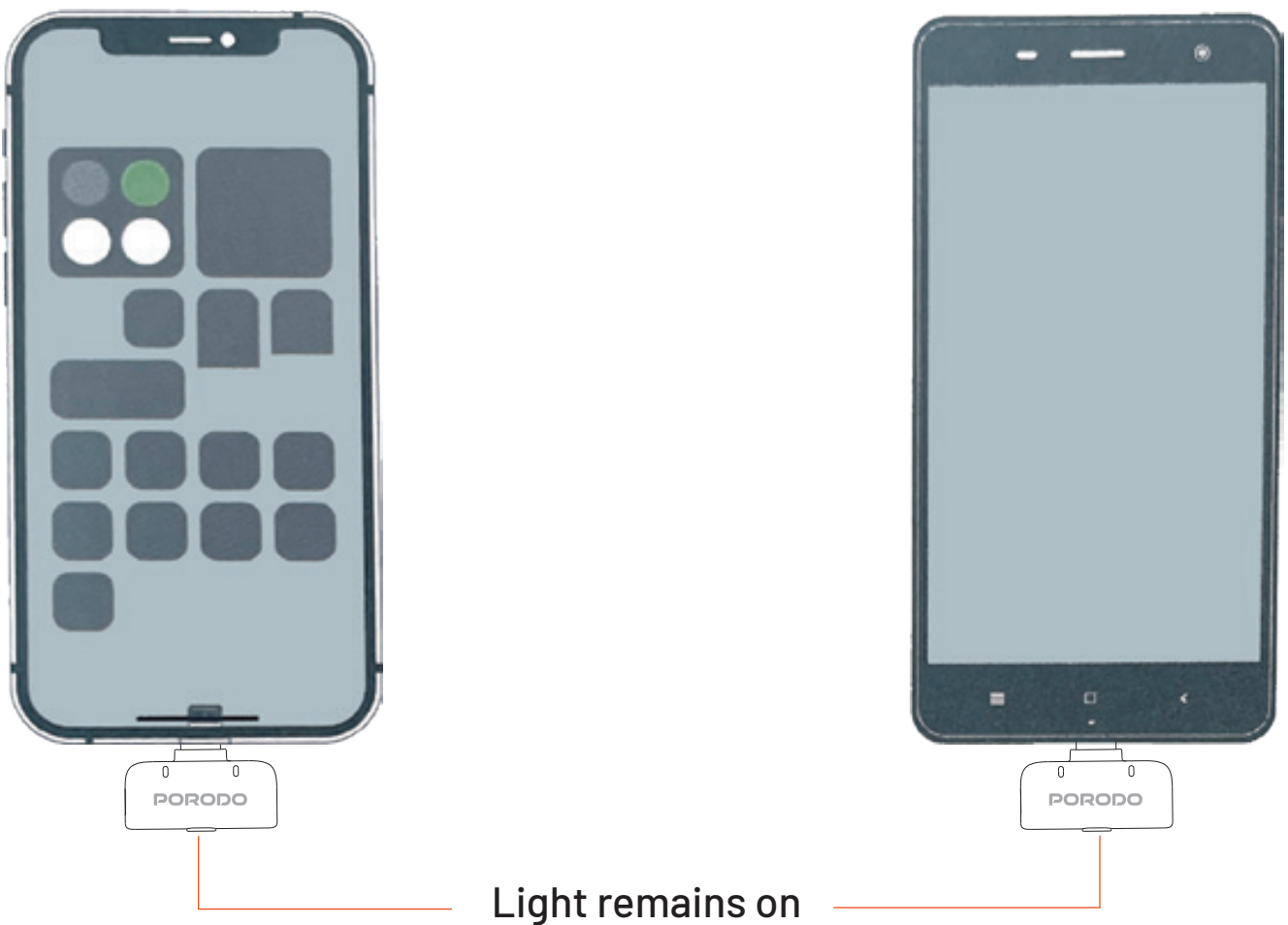


2. Press and hold the power button on the microphone. Once the light indicator turns on, this confirms that the microphone is powered on and ready for use.

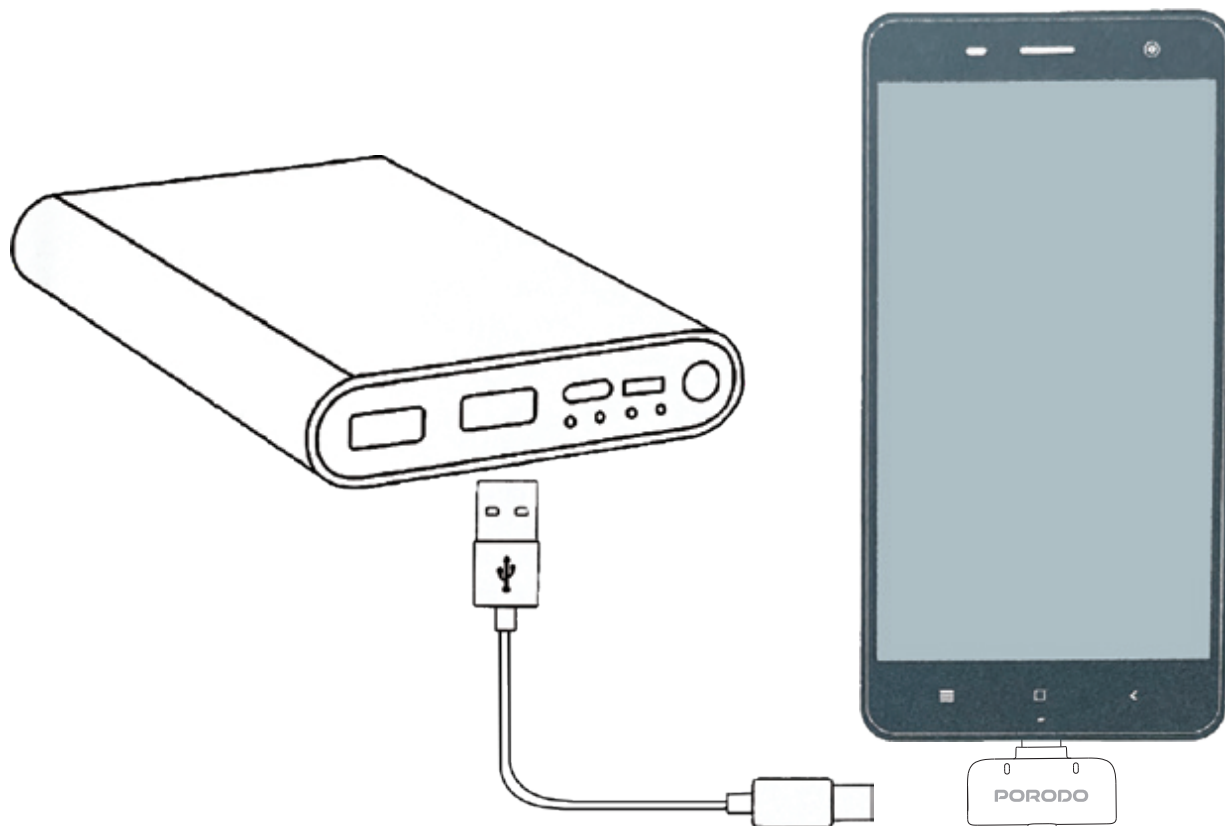
Power On/Off



3. Ensure that the indicator light on both the receiver and the microphone is continuously illuminated. This signifies that the connection has been successfully established. Next, open your preferred live video app on your phone. You can now use the microphone to capture and transmit audio during your session.



4. If the phone's battery is running low during a live broadcast, the external power supply can directly charge the phone through the receiver's charging port, ensuring uninterrupted performance throughout the broadcast.



Operation Guide

1. Microphone TX Operation

| Function | Operation Instructions | LED Indicator | Notes |
|----------------------|---|--|--------------------------|
| Power on | Hold the TX power button for 2 seconds. | The connection light flashes slowly | / |
| Power Off | +Hold the TX power button for 3 seconds. | All lights off | / |
| | +Auto-shutdown after 3 minutes if not connected to RZ. | No flashing lights | / |
| Connect to RX | Hold TX for 2 seconds to pair TX and RX when RX is charging on the phone. | After TX and RX are connected, the TX light stays on, and the RX light stays on. | / |
| Disconnect from RX | Power off RX or TX to shut down. | When disconnected, the TX light flashes slowly, and the RX light flashes. | / |
| Power Control Button | Click to mute, click again to unmute. | Light on = mute, Light off = unmute. | / |
| Control Buttons | +Click to turn off noise reduction, click again to turn on. | On = light on, Off = light off (reverb flashing). | Noise reduction: Enabled |
| | +Double-click to turn on mud sound, double-click again to turn off reverberation. | On = Reverb light on, Off = Reverb light off. | Reverb: Off |
| Charging | Plug in a 5V charger. | Light on until full, then turns off | / |

2. Receiver RX Operation

| Disconnected | TX and RX automatically pair when RX is plugged into the phone charging port. | RX: Two lights flashing | / |
| Successful Connection | Power on TX, connect RX through the phone charging port. TX and RX automatically pair and connect. | Connect a TX: TX1 stays on, TX2 flashes for 15 seconds, then turns off. Connect 2 TXs: Both lights stay on. | / |
| Key Function | +Press the button to mute/unmute. | +RX: Two lights flash slowly | / |
| | +Double-click to switch between stereo and mono. | +RX: Two lights flash slowly three times | Default mono channel |

Package Contents

1. Microphone transmitter (TX)
2. Receiver (RX)
3. Charging case
4. Type-C charging cable

Safety Precautions

1. Keep the microphone dry and away from moisture or liquid spills. Moisture can damage the microphone and affect performance.
2. Keep the volume at a safe level during use to avoid hearing damage. Start with a lower volume and gradually increase it to your desired level.
