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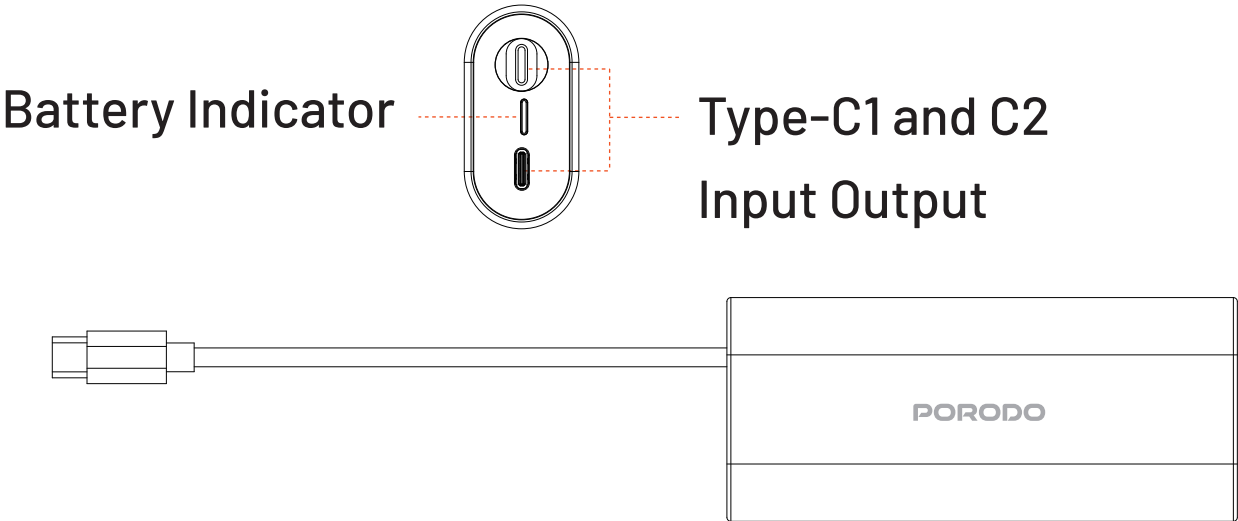

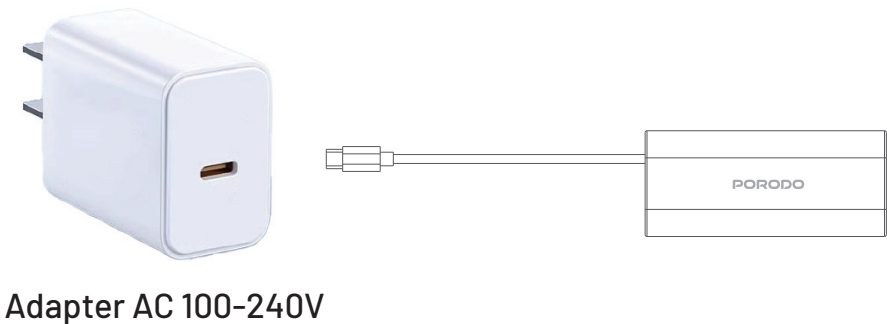
Schematic View



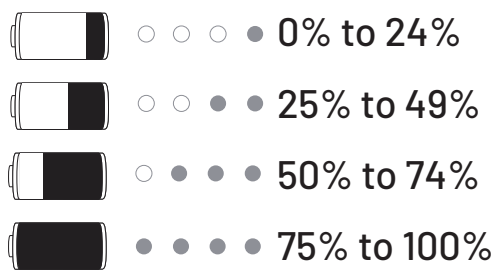
Input	Charging the power bank

Instructions for Use

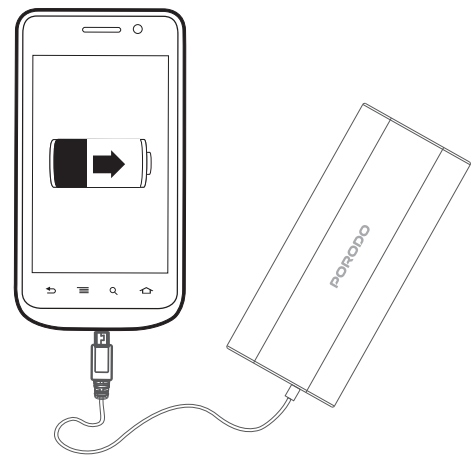
- 1. Charging the Power Bank
 - 1.1 During charging, the white indicator will flicker.
 - 1.2 The power bank will stop flashing and all indicators will turn white once fully charged.
 - 1.3 Please disconnect the adapter safely after the power bank is fully charged.



- 2. Charging Digital Devices:
 - 2.1 Connect the power bank to the digital device to initiate charging.
 - 2.2 A blinking light signifies recharging, while a solid light indicates the device is fully charged.

Matters Needing Attention

1. Avoid storing the equipment in high temperature or high humidity environments to prevent overheating and internal short circuits.
2. Do not exceed a storage temperature of 45 degrees Celsius; prolonged exposure to high temperatures can adversely affect the equipment's service life.
3. Disconnect the equipment from the power source if not in use for an extended period.
4. Operate the device at least once every six months to ensure longevity.
5. Seek assistance from qualified personnel in case of malfunction.
6. Do not disassemble the equipment without proper authorization.

Safety Precautions

1. Ensure you read all instructions before using the product.
2. Close supervision is necessary when the product is used near children to reduce the risk of injury.
3. Do not insert fingers or hands into the product.
4. Avoid exposing the power bank to rain or snow.
5. Use only power supplies or chargers recommended or sold by the power pack manufacturer to avoid risks of fire or injury.
6. Do not operate the power bank beyond its output rating; exceeding this may lead to a risk of fire or injury.
7. Do not use the power bank if it is damaged or has modified batteries, as this can lead to unpredictable behavior, fire, explosions, or injuries.
8. Do not disassemble the power bank. If service or repair is needed, take it to a qualified service person. Incorrect reassembly may pose a risk of fire or injury.
9. Avoid exposing the power bank to fire or excessive temperatures. Temperatures exceeding 100°C (212°F) may cause explosions.
10. Ensure servicing is performed by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts to maintain safety and functionality.

11. Turn off the power bank when not in use.
