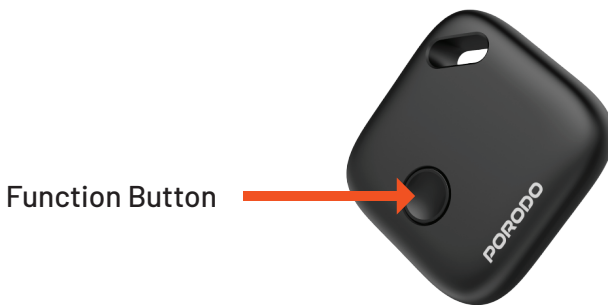
## Getting Started

### 1. Power On/Off

- a. Press the function button of the product to turn it on. You will hear a start up tone.
- b. To power off, hold the same button for at least 3 seconds. You will hear 2 beeps indicating the tag is powered off.

### 2. Checking for Updates

To use the Apple find My app for locating your smart tag, it is recommended to use the latest version of iOS, iPadOS, or macOS.



## Connecting the Smart Tag

### 1. Start the App

open "Find My" app on you iPhone or iPad, and allow notifications from the app.

### 2. Connecting the Smart Tag

- a. Turn on the smart tag.
- b. In the "Find my" app, select the items tab.
- c. click on "Add item", then select "other supported items".
- d. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth and search for "Findora".
- e. Choose a recognizable name and emoji for your smart tag and tap continue.
- f. "Find My" app will ask for confirmation to add your smart tag to your Apple ID. Tap finish and your smart tag will be set up and ready to be connected to whatever item you wish to locate.

## Locating your item

1. Finding the smart tag when it is Nearby.
  - a. Open the Find My app and select the "Items" tab.
  - b. Tap on your smart tag from the list.
  - c. Tap "Play Sound" to make your smart tag beep.
  - d. Tap "Stop Sound" to stop the beeping once you find your item.
2. Finding smart tag's Last Known Location.
  - a. Open the Find My app and select the "Items" tab.
  - b. Tap on your smart tag from the list.
  - c. Your smart tag's last known location will appear on the map as the emoji you chose during setup.
  - d. To navigate to that last known location, tap "Directions" to open the Maps™ app.

## Finding an Out of Range Item

1. Enabling "Notify When Left Behind".
  - a. Open the "Find My" app and select the "Items" tab.
  - b. Tap on your smart tag from the list.
  - c. Under "Notifications," enable the "Notify When Left Behind" toggle.

d. You will receive a notification when you leave your smart tag behind and it's no longer in the range of your device.

## 2. Enabling "Notify When Found"

a. Under "Notifications," enable the "Notify When Found" toggle

b. When your smart tag is seen by the "Find My" app on another device, you will receive a notification of its updated location

**Note:** "Notify When Found" can only be activated when your smart tag is out of range.

## Lost Mode Function

1. Open the Find My app and select the "Items" tab.

2. Tap on your smart tag from the list.

3. Under "Lost Mode," tap "Enable".

4. A screen detailing Lost Mode will pop up, tap "Continue".

5. Enter your phone number or email address and tap "Next".

6. Optionally, you may enter a message to be shared with the person who finds your item.

7. Tap "Activate" to enable "Lost Mode".

**Note:** When "Lost Mode" is enabled, "Notify When Found" is automatically enabled.

**Note:** When "Lost Mode" is enabled, your Item Locator is locked and cannot be paired to a new device.

## Resetting Your Smart Tag

1. Remove the smart tag from the Find My app

a. Open the Find My app and select the "Items" tab

b. Tap on your smart tag from the list

- c. Ensure that “Lost Mode” is disabled
  - d. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and tap “Remove Item.”
  - e. A summary will appear, tap “Remove” to confirm
- 2. Factory Reset Your smart tag**
- a. After successfully removing the smart tag from the Find My app (when the device is turned on), press the button five times continuously.
  - b. At the fifth long press, do not release your hand until you hear the prompt tone.
  - c. The smart tag is now reset and ready to be paired with a new device.

## Charging

- a. This product supports cyclic charging.
- b. A red light stays on during charging.
- c. A green light stays on when fully charged.

## Unwanted Tracking Detection

If your iPhone detects that an unknown smart tag that is traveling with you, it will send you a notification. A sound will play, helping you locate it. These alerts are only activated when a smart tag is not connected to its owner’s phone, so your paired smart tag will not trigger a sound if they are with you.

## FCC Statement
